











# AB 643 (Wilson) - Organic Waste Procurement Target

### **Details**

 Would authorize a local jurisdiction to include organic material used as a beneficial agricultural amendment towards its recovered organic waste procurement target

#### **Status**

- Two-Year bill
- OC San will look to include language to better reflect potential future projects
- OC San is currently in a watch position

### SB 682 (Allen) - Non-Essential PFAS Use Ban

### **Details**

- Prohibits the distribution, sale, or offering for sale of consumer products containing intentionally added per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) on a graduated timeline
- Requires the Department of Toxic Substances Control, upon a petition from a manufacturer, to review and determine whether the use of PFAS in a product is a currently unavoidable use

### **Status**

- Passed both the Senate Environmental Quality Committee and Senate Health Committee
- Currently in the Senate Appropriations Committee
- OC San joined the CASA supported coalition letter

## SB 496 (Hurtado) – Advanced Clean Fleets (ACF)

### **Details**

- Creates the ACF Regulation Appeals Advisory Committee
- Expands existing ACF emergency vehicle exemptions to vehicles reasonably anticipated to respond to emergency situations or vehicles supporting those efforts

### **Status**

- Passed the Senate Environmental Quality Committee and the Senate Transportation Committee
- Currently in the Senate Appropriations Committee
- OC San submitted a letter of support
