

RESOLUTION NO. OCSD 20-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ORANGE COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT, AUTHORIZING THE ORANGE COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT'S TREASURER TO INVEST AND/OR REINVEST THE ORANGE COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT'S FUNDS, ADOPTING THE ORANGE COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT'S INVESTMENT POLICY STATEMENT AND PERFORMANCE BENCHMARKS, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. OCSD 19-21

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2019, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 19-21, readopting the Orange County Sanitation District's ("Sanitation District") Investment Policy Statement, and establishing specific performance benchmarks and objectives, together with a schedule of frequency of investment performance reports; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code Section 53607, the Board of Directors may delegate authority to invest and/or reinvest the Sanitation District's funds to the Treasurer for a one-year period; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code Section 53646, the Sanitation District is required to review its Investment Policy annually and readopt its Policy at a public meeting, which Policy will establish specific performance benchmarks and objectives, and specific monitoring and reports.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Orange County Sanitation District, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER:

Section 1: That the authority of the Board of Directors to invest or reinvest surplus funds, or to sell or exchange securities so purchased, or to deposit for safekeeping the funds and investments of the Sanitation District with depositories, as provided for in California Government Code Sections 53608 and 53630, is hereby delegated to the Sanitation District's Treasurer for a one-year period, January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, as authorized by California Government Code Section 53607.

Section 2: That the Board of Directors hereby adopts the Investment Policy Statement of the Orange County Sanitation District.

Section 3: That the Board of Directors hereby adopts the following specific performance benchmarks for their two investment funds in accordance with Section 16.0 of the Sanitation District's Investment Policy:

LIQUID OPERATING MONIES: The Short-Term Operating Fund will be compared to the three-month Bank of America Merrill Lynch T-Bill Index and the Callan Money Market Funds.

LONG-TERM OPERATING MONIES: The Long-Term Operating Fund will be compared to the Bank of America Merrill Lynch Corporate and Government One-to-Five Year Maturity Index and to the Callan Short Term Fixed Income Group.

Section 4: That the Board of Directors hereby adopts a performance monitoring and reporting schedule, as required by Section 17.0 of the Sanitation District's Investment Policy.

Section 5: That Resolution No. OCSD 19-21 is hereby repealed.
