





Fifth graders will discover the causes and effects of fatbergs and work on a solution to prevent them.





Middle school students will investigate the origin of a contaminant and design a method to safeguard the system or create an argument explaining how changing factors can affect populations within an ecosystem



High School students will evaluate belt presses and centrifuges as technological solutions to a problem of human impact on the environment.
