With over seven years of experience as an active Orange County Sanitation Board Member and leader, along with my extensive public agency and private sector management experience, I am prepared and eager for this challenging responsibility. As the Board's Vice Chair, I would support the Board's policies and priorities in upholding public health and the environment. Working with the Board's Chair, I would continue to seek opportunities to use my administrative and organizational knowledge to improve the District's efficiency and effectiveness.

Currently, I serve as the Chair of the District's Audit and Administration Committees and am a three-year member of the Steering Committee.
