












Public Input Solicitation

Mailouts and Notifications:

- AB-52 Notifications to California Native American tribes
- Public Posting Orange County Register & Libraries
- Properties around Treatment Plants
- Adjacent to pump stations and easement areas
- Cities, Special Districts, State agencies, Federal agencies, environmental organizations such as HB Wetlands Cons.
- Over 3,000 letters mailed




