 - \$80 Billion State Revolving Fund (SRF)
 - \$50 Million/year: Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act WIFIA
 - \$500 Million Smart Water Tech Grants
 - \$5 Million Workforce Grants
 - \$1 Billion Pretreatment StandardsGrants: PFAS
