

NPDES Permit – Discharge Monitoring Reporting


- Regulatory Driver: NPDES
 Permit Discharge limits and
 Performance Goals
- Monitoring: Over 12,500 analyses per year
- Reporting Frequency:
 Monthly, quarterly, semiannually, and annual
- Inspections: EPA and Regional Water Quality Control Board
- Internal Audits: Annual


