APPROVING PROVISIONS FOR SATISFACTION OF PAYMENT OF FICA TAXES FOR DIRECTOR-EMPLOYEES MANDATED BY FEDERAL OMNIBUS BUDGET RECONCILIATION ACT OF 1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ORANGE COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT (OC SAN), APPROVING PAYMENT BY THE DISTRICTOC SAN TO THE DISTRICT'SOC SAN'S 457(b) DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN ("457 PLAN") FUND ON BEHALF OF DISTRICT OC SAN'S DIRECTOREMPLOYEES IN LIEU OF CONTRIBUTIONS PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL INSURANCE CONTRIBUTIONS ACT ("FICA"), AS MANDATED BY THE FEDERAL OMNIBUS BUDGET RECONCILIATION ACT OF 1990 ("OBRA"); AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. OCSD 98-4.

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of Supervisors, by approval on April 14, 1998 of County Resolution No. 98-140, has ordered the consolidation of County Sanitation Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 11, 13 and 14 of Orange County, California (the "Predecessor Districts"), into a single new district to be known as the Orange County Sanitation District (the "District"); and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 57500, the District succeeds to all of the powers, rights, duties, obligations, functions, and properties of the Predecessor Districts; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Congress enacted the Federal Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990 ("OBRA"), changing several provisions of the Federal Social Security Act, as applied to local government entity employees; and,

WHEREAS, OBRA amended the prior law by adding a new Section 3121(b)(7)(F) to the Internal Revenue Code, by expanding the definition of "employment" for Federal Insurance Contribution Act ("FICA") tax purposes, to include service performed after July 1, 1991, as an employee for a local government entity, unless the employee is a member of a retirement system of such entity; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of OBRA require compliance with the requirement to make FICA contributions on behalf of local government agency employees by not later than December 31, 1991; and,

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service has adopted final regulations under Section 3121((b)()(7)()(F) of the Internal Revenue Code, containing rules relating to local government entity employees and determination of membership in the local entity retirement system; and,

WHEREAS, the District'S OC San's Director-Employees are not eligible for participation in the District's OC San's Retirement Plan, to wit: County of Orange Employees Retirement System; and,

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service regulations allow a contribution into an Internal Revenue Code Section 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan, as meeting the requirements for retirement system contribution, in lieu of making the contributions to FICA; and,

WHEREAS, the Predecessor Districts OC San enacted Resolution No. 81-16698-4, effective October 14, 1981 July 1, 1998, authorizing OC San's Directors to participate in OC San's the Districts' 457(b) Deferred Compensation Plan ("457 Plan"); and,

WHEREAS, the <u>OC San Directors</u> have determined that they can satisfy the legal requirements of Internal Revenue Code Section 3121(b)(7)(F) in the most cost effective manner, by having the <u>District OC San</u> contribute the minimum sum authorized by Internal Revenue Service regulation, to wit: 7.5% <u>of theoformologies the Director-eEmployee's</u> -compensation- to <u>the District's OC San's 457 Deferred Compensation Plan Fund.</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of Orange County Sanitation District, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ORANGE COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER:

DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER:

Section 1: Pursuant to Internal Revenue Code Section 3121{(b){)(7){)(F)}, the District OC San approves the payment of the sum equal to 7.5% of the compensation payable to each Director into the District's OC San's Deferred Compensation457 Plan account. Said contributions will be made in accordance with the District's OC San's Internal Revenue Code Section 457 Plan, and Plan and shall be made on behalf of each OC San District Director-Employee.

<u>Section 2</u>: Upon payment of the sums set forth above, no payments are required, nor shall be made on behalf of, any of the <u>District's OC San's</u> Director-Employees pursuant to the <u>Federal Insurance Contributions Act ("FICA")</u>, except the health insurance portion (currently 1.45%) of the FICA tax for those Director-

Employees who commenced service with the District OC San on or after April 1,1986. OC SAN 23-XX-3 <u>Section 4.2 The aAppendix I to Schedule A</u> of the <u>District's OC San's Deferred Compensation457</u> Plan, providing for a minimum annual contribution of \$300.00650.00 per year, is hereby ordered waived on behalf of the contributions to be made on behalf of each <u>District OC San Director-Employee</u>.

<u>Section 4:</u> That the contributions provided for in Section 1 hereof shall commence with payment of any compensation after <u>July 1, 1998 January 25, 2023</u>.
