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Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP)

- SSMP describes how the agency will operate and maintain their collection system to reduce occurrence of sanitary sewer overflows.
- All public agencies that own or operate sanitary sewer systems must develop and implement a SSMP.

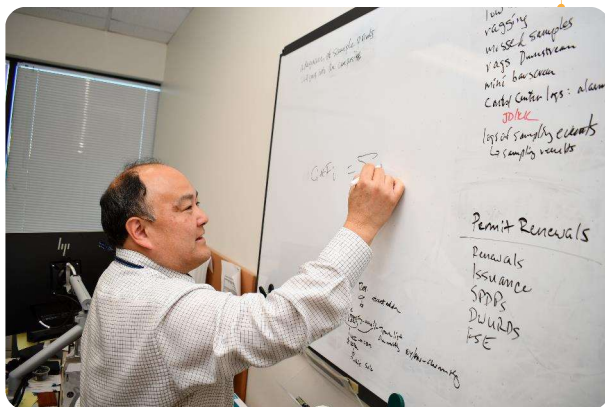


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SSMP Update

- Sanitary Sewer System Waste Discharge Requirement (WDR) Order (2022 Order).
- Update OC San's current 2021 SSMP to comply with the 2022 Order.



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SSMP Update

How did OC San update the SSMP?

- OC San hired an independent third party to conduct a comprehensive review to ensure that the 2025 SSMP complies with the 2022 Order and reflects OC San's current practices.
- Staff from multiple departments collaborated to incorporate the recommendations from the independent third-party review into the 2025 SSMP.

Additions

- Description of CCTV program
- Equipment inventory

- Root control program
- Description of inter-agency coordination
- Procedures for prompt notification and response to a spill
- Language for annual review and assessment of the effectiveness of the Spill Emergency Response Plan
